### September      **RIGHTEOUS KIDS**

Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. **Colossians 3:12 (NIV)**

<sup>22</sup>But the Spirit produces the fruit of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup>gentleness, self-control. There is no law that says these things are wrong. **Galatians 5:22-23 (ICB)**

<sup>12</sup>My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. <sup>13</sup>Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. <sup>14</sup>You are My friends if you do what I command. <sup>15</sup>I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know His master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from My Father I have made known to you. **John 15:12-15 (NIV)**

<sup>5</sup>If any of you needs wisdom, you should ask God for it. God is generous. He enjoys giving to all people, so God will give you wisdom. <sup>6</sup>But when you ask God, you must believe. Do not doubt God. Anyone who doubts is like a wave in the sea. The wind blows the wave up and down. **James 1:5-6 (ICB)**

But the wisdom that comes from God is like this: First, it is pure. Then it is also peaceful, gentle, and easy to please. This wisdom is always ready to help those who are troubled and to do good for others. This wisdom is always fair and honest. **James 3:17(ICB)**

### October      **THANKFUL HEARTS**

Remember that I commanded you to be strong and brave. So don't be afraid. The Lord your God will be with you everywhere you go. **Joshua 1:9 (ICB)**

## January WHO YOU ARE IN CHRIST

<sup>8</sup> For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—<sup>9</sup> not by works, so that no one can boast.<sup>10</sup> For we are God’s handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. **Ephesians 2:8-10 (NIV)**

The LORD will make you the head, not the tail. If you pay attention to the commands of the LORD your God that I give you this day and carefully follow them, you will always be at the top, never at the bottom.

## **February                      LAF - LOVE, ACCEPT, FORGIVE**

<sup>4</sup> Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. <sup>5</sup> It does not dishonour others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup> Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. **1 Corinthians 13:4-6 (NIV)**

<sup>7</sup> Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. <sup>8</sup> Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. **1 John 4:7-8 (NIV)**

<sup>37</sup> Jesus replied: ‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’<sup>38</sup> This is the first and greatest commandment.<sup>39</sup> And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbour as yourself.’  
**Matthew 22:37-39 (NIV)**

<sup>13</sup> bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also. **Colossians 3:13 (NKJV)**

## **March                                      RENEWING THE MIND**

<sup>2</sup> Praise the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits; <sup>3</sup> who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, <sup>4</sup> who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, <sup>5</sup> who satisfies your desires with good things. **Psalms 103:2-5 (NIV) (Healing of mind and body)**

He heals the broken hearted. He bandages their wounds. **Psalms 147:3 (ICB) (Healing of mind and body)**

<sup>4</sup> Surely He took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by Him, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup> But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on Him, and by His wounds we are healed. **Isaiah 53:4-5 (NIV)**

A good man out of the good treasure of His heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things. **Matthew 12:35 (NKJV)**

Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective. **James 5:16 (NIV)**

## April **PROMISES OF GOD**

My sheep listen to My voice. I know them, and they follow Me. I give them eternal life, and they will never die. And no person can steal them out of My hand. **John 10:27-28 (ICB)**

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. **1 John 5:14 (NIV)**

“For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.” **Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV)**

Being confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. **Philippians 1:6 (NIV)**

But my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. **Philippians 4:19 (NIV)**

## May/June **TELL THE WORLD**

<sup>25</sup> Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in Me will live, even though they die; <sup>26</sup> and whoever lives by believing in Me will never die. Do you believe this? **John 11:25-26 (NIV)**

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. **Romans 6:23 (NIV)**

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. **John 10:10 (NIV)**

<sup>8</sup> For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—<sup>9</sup> not by works, so that no one can boast. **Ephesians 2: 8-9 (NIV)**

<sup>19</sup> Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” **Matthew 28:19-20 (NIV)**

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God. **Romans 10:17 (NKJV)**
