

## Elementary Scripture Memory –*Grade 6*

### September      **RIGHTEOUS KIDS**

<sup>5</sup> If any of you needs wisdom, you should ask God for it. God is generous. He enjoys giving to all people, so God will give you wisdom. <sup>6</sup> But when you ask God, you must believe. Do not doubt God. Anyone who doubts is like a wave in the sea. The wind blows the wave up and down. **James 1:5-6 (ICB)**

But the wisdom that comes from God is like this: First, it is pure. Then it is also peaceful, gentle, and easy to please. This wisdom is always ready to help those who are troubled and to do good for others. This wisdom is always fair and honest. **James 3:17(ICB)**

<sup>10</sup> Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His great power. <sup>11</sup> Wear the full armor of God. Wear God's armour so that you can fight against the devil's evil tricks. <sup>12</sup> Our fight is not against people on earth. We are fighting against the rulers and authorities and the powers of this world's darkness. We are fighting against the spiritual powers of evil in the heavenly world. <sup>13</sup> That is why you need to get God's full armor. Then on the day of evil you will be able to stand strong. And when you have finished the whole fight, you will still be standing. **Ephesians 6:10-13 (ICB)**

<sup>14</sup> Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, <sup>15</sup> and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. <sup>16</sup> In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. <sup>17</sup> Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. <sup>18</sup> And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people. **Ephesians 6:14-18 (NIV)**

### October      **THANKFUL HEARTS**

Everything you say and everything you do should all be done for Jesus your Lord. And in all you do, give thanks to God the Father through Jesus. **Colossians 3:17 (ICB)**

<sup>6</sup> The person who plants a little will have a small harvest. But the person who plants a lot will have a big harvest. Each one should give, then, what he has decided in his heart to give. He should not give if it makes him sad. And he should not give if he thinks he is forced to give. God loves the person who gives happily. **2 Corinthians 9:6-7 (ICB)**

<sup>6</sup> Do not worry about anything. But pray and ask God for everything you need. And you pray, always giving thanks. <sup>7</sup> And God's peace will keep your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. The peace that God gives is so great that we cannot understand it. <sup>8</sup> Brothers, continue to think about the things that are good and worthy of

praise. Think about the things that are true and honorable and right and pure and beautiful and respected.

## December JESUS, GOD'S GIFT TO THE WORLD

But Christ died for us while we were still sinners. In this way God shows His great love for us. **Romans 5:8 (ICB)**

The payment for sin is death. But God gives us the free gift of life forever in Christ Jesus our Lord. **Romans 6:23 (ICB)**

<sup>8</sup>And when He was living as a man, He humbled Himself and was fully obedient to God. He obeyed even when that caused His death—death on a cross.<sup>9</sup> So God raised Christ to the highest place. God made the name of Christ greater than every other name.<sup>10</sup> God wants every knee to bow to Jesus—everyone in heaven, on earth, and under the earth. **Philippians 2:8-10 (ICB)**

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him. **John 3:16-17 (NIV)**

Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under Heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved. **Acts 4:12 (NIV)**

## January                      WHO YOU ARE IN CHRIST

The LORD will make you the head, not the tail. If you pay attention to the commands of the LORD your God that I give you this day and carefully follow them, you will always be at the top, never at the bottom.

**Deuteronomy 28:13 (NIV)**

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light. **1 Peter 2:9 (NIV)**

<sup>37</sup> But in all these things we have full victory through God who showed His love for us. <sup>38-39</sup> Yes, I am sure that nothing can separate us from the love God has for us. Not death, not life, not angels, not ruling spirits, nothing now, nothing in the future, no powers, nothing above us, nothing below us, or anything else in the whole world will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. **Romans 8:37-39 (ICB)**

God has made us what we are. In Christ Jesus, God made us new people so that we would do good works. God had planned in advance for us those good works for us. He had planned for us to live our lives doing them. **Ephesians 2:10 (ICB)**

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. **Galatians 2:20 (NIV)**

He has saved us and called us to a holy life, not because of anything we have done but because of His own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time. **2 Timothy 1:9 (NIV)**

<sup>19</sup> Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; <sup>20</sup> you were bought at a price. Therefore honour God with your bodies. **1 Corinthians 6:19-20 (NIV)**

## February                      LAF - LOVE, ACCEPT, FORGIVE

<sup>13</sup> bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also. **Colossians 3:13 (NKJV)**

Respect everyone, and love your Christian brothers and sisters. Fear God, and respect the king. **1 Peter 2:17 (NIV)**

"How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!" **1 John 3:1 (NIV)**

<sup>3</sup> When you do things, do not let selfishness or pride be your guide. Be humble and give more honour to others than to yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Do not be interested only in your own life, but be interested in the lives of others.

**Philippians 2:3-4 (ICB)**

So now, those who are in Christ Jesus are not judged guilty. **Romans 8:1 (ICB)**

For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins. **Matthew 6:14-15 (NIV)**

Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. **Luke 6:37 (NIV)**

## March **RENEWING THE MIND**

A good man out of the good treasure of His heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things. **Matthew 12:35 (NKJV)**

Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective. **James 5:16 (NIV)**

<sup>22</sup> You were taught to leave your old self—to stop living the evil way you lived before. That old self becomes worse because people are fooled by the evil things they want to do. <sup>23</sup> But you were taught to be made new in your hearts. <sup>24</sup> You were taught to become a new person. That new person is made to be like God—made to be truly good and holy. <sup>25</sup> So you must stop telling lies. Tell each other the truth because we all belong to each other in the same body. **Ephesians 4:22-25 (ICB)**

When you are angry, do not sin. And do not go on being angry all day. **Ephesians 4:26 (ICB)**

Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—His good, pleasing and perfect will. **Romans 12:2 (NIV)**

He himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by His wounds you have been healed. **1 Peter 2:24 (NIV)**

<sup>2</sup> Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well. <sup>3</sup> It gave me great joy when some believers came and testified about your faithfulness to the truth, telling how you continue to walk in it. **3 John 2-3 (NIV)**

## April      **PROMISES OF GOD**

But my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. **Philippians 4:19 (NIV)**

<sup>38</sup> For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, <sup>39</sup> neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. **Romans 8:38-39 (NIV)**

So I tell you to ask for things in prayer. And if you believe that you have received those things, then they will be yours. **Mark 11:24 (ICB)**

With God's power working in us, God can do much, much more than anything we can ask or think of. **Ephesians 3:20 (ICB)**

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose. **Romans 8:28 (NIV)**

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. **1 John 1:9 (NIV)**

## May/June      **TELL THE WORLD**

<sup>19</sup> Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." **Matthew 28:19-20 (NIV)**

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God. **Romans 10:17 (NKJV)**

<sup>17</sup> Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!<sup>18</sup> All this is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation. that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. **2 Corinthians 5:17-19 () (for teaching, not memorizing)**

I do not live anymore—it is Christ living in me. I still live in my body, but I live by faith in the Son of God. He loved me and gave Himself to save me. **Galatians 2:20 (ICB)**

But the Holy Spirit will come to you. Then you will receive power. You will be My witnesses—in Jerusalem, in all of Judea, in Samaria, and in every part of the world." **Acts 1:8 (ICB)**

<sup>9</sup> If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. **Romans 10:9-10 (NIV)**

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him. **Hebrews 11:6 (NIV)**
