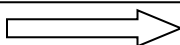

- ✓ Jr High Students eligible for exam exemptions will be notified on **Monday January 21st**
- ✓ Sr High Students eligible for exam exemptions will be notified on **Friday January 18th**
- ✓ Mark must be 80% or above, with no more than 5 lates or 5 absences in each course and no outstanding NHI work.
- ✓ No exemptions for:
 - Jr High ELA midterm
 - Grade 11 Math
 - Grade 11 ELA
 - Grade 12 Math/ELA (*Provincial Exams*)
- ✓ When scheduled to write an exam, please go to the classroom for who's exam you are writing for O Canada, attendance. You will then be instructed to proceed to your designated area to write your exam.
- ✓ Remember to hand in your textbooks to the library either before or after your exam.
- ✓ No electronics are allowed during the writing of exams. They will be collected before the exam begins.
- ✓ You are required to stay at your exam for 2 hours minimum.
- ✓ All students need to make arrangements to be picked up by 12:00, immediately after their exam.
- ✓ The shuttle bus will run in the morning only for Thursday January 24 & 25th.
