- **Reflect on the Word** - think about the verses and how they apply to your life
- **Interact with the Word** - use the verses to complete additional assignments

Students who complete each of their Scripture Projects with a mark of 80% or better will qualify for the year-end Scripture Award. Outside of artistic projects, all written work **MUST be typed**.

#### **2 Timothy 3:14-17 - New International Version (NIV)**

<sup>14</sup> But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, <sup>15</sup> and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> so that the servant of God<sup>[a]</sup> may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

#### **Deuteronomy 11:18-23 - New International Version (NIV)**

<sup>18</sup> Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. <sup>19</sup> Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. <sup>20</sup> Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates,<sup>21</sup> so that your days and the days of your children may be many in the land the LORD swore to give your ancestors, as many as the days that the heavens are above the earth.

<sup>22</sup> If you carefully observe all these commands I am giving you to follow—to love the LORD your God, to walk in obedience to him and to hold fast to him— <sup>23</sup> then the LORD will drive out all these nations before you, and you will dispossess nations larger and stronger than you.

#### **Romans 8:1-10 - New International Version (NIV) - Life Through the Spirit**

<sup>1</sup>Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, <sup>2</sup> because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you<sup>[a]</sup> free from the law of sin and death. <sup>3</sup>For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh,<sup>[b]</sup> God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a sin offering.<sup>[c]</sup> And so he condemned sin in the flesh, <sup>4</sup> in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

<sup>5</sup> Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. <sup>6</sup> The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace. <sup>7</sup> The mind governed by the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. <sup>8</sup> Those who are in the realm of the flesh cannot please God.

<sup>9</sup> You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ. <sup>10</sup> But if Christ is in you, then even though your body is subject to death because of sin, the Spirit gives life<sup>[d]</sup> because of righteousness.



**Part 3: Interact with the Word (10 marks each)**

YOUR CHOICE! Do as many activities as you need to total 60 marks for Project.

1. Research the Biblical context of one of the verses. Who wrote the verse? When was it written? To whom was it directed? Why is this verse still important today?
2. Create a "word search" using 10 of the words in the Scripture. Give the definition of each word chosen. Tell why you chose these particular words and how they are important to the topic/theme of the Scripture.
3. Write new lyrics to an existing song or rap that highlight the key verses in this Scripture.
4. Create an original piece of artwork based on this Scripture. Tell why you made the artistic choices you did and how they relate to the Scripture.
5. Pick 10 key words from the Scripture. Find out the Greek or Hebrew derivative for each word and give the original meaning of the word. How does knowing the original meaning of the word expand your understanding of the Scripture?
6. Choose one of the verses and write a devotional which includes the verse, commentary, including at least one other verse, and a prayer. Use Pastor Leon's *Devoted* devotional as a guideline.
7. Read the Message version of these verses. How are the translations the same? Different? Do you feel the Message version captures the essence of these verses? Why or why not?
8. Find a song that is the same theme as these verses. Write out the lyrics. Why do you think it relates to this Scripture? What made this song stand out to you?
9. Find another 10 Scripture verses that fit this theme. Write out the verse and the reference. How do you think the verses you chose fit the theme?
10. Create a media project with sound and images to bring a new dimension to the Scripture. Tell why you chose the music and pictures that you did?
11. Make a suggestion to the teacher, and get approval, for another way to interact with the Word.
