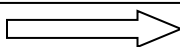

- ✓ Jr High Students eligible for exam exemptions will be notified on **Monday June 17th**
- ✓ Sr High Students eligible for exam exemptions will be notified on **Thursday June 13th**
- ✓ Mark must be 80% or above, with no more than 5 lates or 5 absences in each course and no outstanding NHI work. (10 absences all year for Jr High)
- ✓ No exemptions for:
 - Jr High Math
 - Jr High ELA
 - Grade 9 Math
 - Grade 11 Math
 - Grade 11 ELA
 - Grade 12 Math/ELA (*Provincial Exams*)
- ✓ Check in with the teacher of the exam you writing for O Canada, attendance. You will then be instructed to proceed to your designated area to write your exam.
- ✓ Remember to hand in your textbooks to the library either before or after your exam.
- ✓ No electronics are allowed during the writing of exams. They will be collected before the exam begins.
- ✓ You are required to stay at your exam for 2 hours minimum.
- ✓ All students need to make arrangements to be picked up by 12:00, immediately after their exam.
- ✓ The shuttle bus will run in the morning only for June 19 & 20th.
