2. Verses can be recited at home **or** at school.

 - If recited at school, Mr. Lazaruk must verify your memorization during a mutually agreed upon lunch hour.
3. **Two marks will be deducted** for each error **or** prompt.
4. Verses must be recited in **1 sitting**. This means you cannot recite these verses over multiple occasions or days.
