Memory Verses:

Romans 8:31-32 (2 verses)

31) What can we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us? **32)** Since God did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't God, who gave us Christ, also give us everything else?

Romans 8:35 (1 verse), 38-39 (2 verses)

35) Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or are hungry or cold or in danger or threatened with death? **38)** And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from his love. Death can't, and life can't. The angels can't, and the demons can't. Our fears for today, our worries about tomorrow, and even the powers of hell can't keep God's love away. **39)** Whether we are high

above the sky or in the deepest ocean, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Proverbs 3:5-6 (2 verses)

5) Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. 6) Seek his will in all you do, and he will direct your paths.

Luke 11:9-10 (2 verses)

9) So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and it will be opened to you. 10) For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks find, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

Romans 8:5-8 (4 verses)

5) Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit. 6) If your sinful nature controls your mind, there is death. But if the Holy Spirit controls your mind, there is life and peace. 7) For the sinful nature is always hostile to God. It never did obey God’s laws, and it never will. 8) That’s why those who are still under the control of their sinful nature can never please God.”

James 3:13-14 (2 verses)

13) If you are wise and understand God’s ways, live a life of steady goodness so that only good deeds will pour forth. And if you don’t brag about the good you do, then you will be truly wise! 14) But if you are bitterly jealous and there is selfish ambition in your hearts, don’t brag about being wise. That is the worst kind of lie.”

Philippians 2:13-15 (3 verses)

13) For God is working in you, giving you the desire to obey him and the power to do what pleases him. 14) In everything you do, stay away from complaining and arguing so that no one can speak a word of blame against you. 15) You are to live clean, innocent lives as children of God in a dark world full of crooked and perverse people. Let your lives shine brightly before them.”

Romans 1:16-17 (2 verses)

16) I am not ashamed of the Good News (gospel) about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes-Jews first and also Gentiles. 17) This Good News tells us how God makes us right in his sight. This is accomplished from start to finish by faith. As the Scriptures say, ‘It is through faith that a righteous person has life’.
